Look around the room. What do you see on people's foreheads? We receive the symbol of the cross on our forehead today, to remind us that we belong to God. We also get a cross on our foreheads during our baptism.

Draw a cross of water on the baby's forehead. Then make a cross of ashes on the

woman's forehead below, reminding us that the cross of Christ never goes away.
