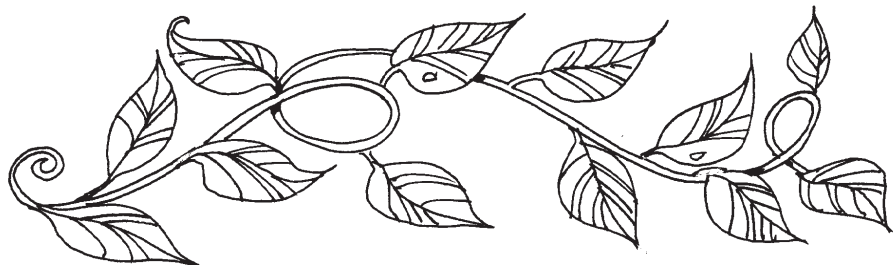

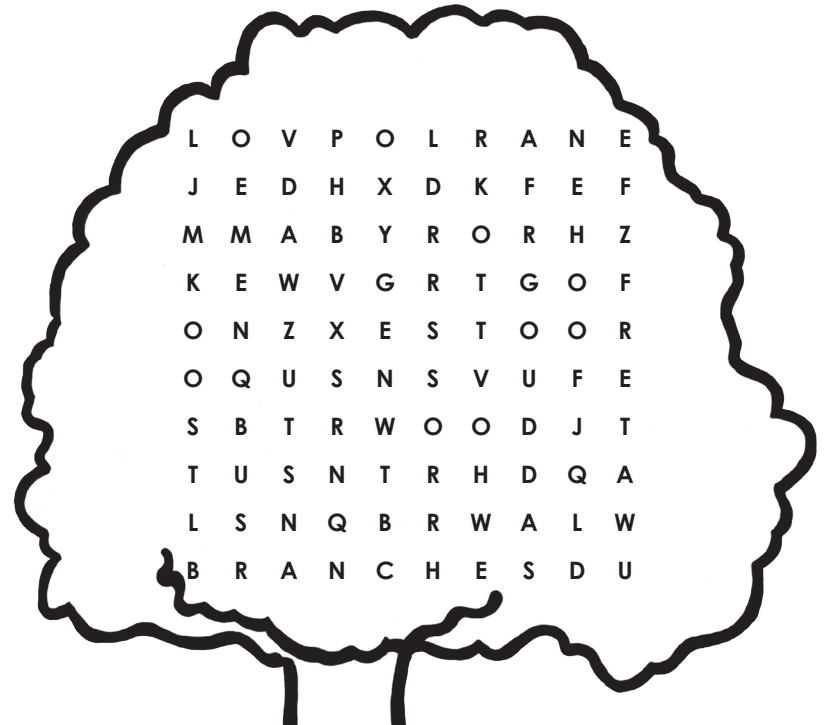
# READER
